## **EYR Students Attend Newsroom Bootcamp**

Seventy primary and secondary students recently attended Newsroom Bootcamp sessions with John Young from BBC South East as part of the run up to Eastbourne Youth Radio in November.

John described what makes the news – new, novel, serious, significant, weird, wonderful and extraordinary and discussed individual story values. Students had to prepare (and then read) news headlines whilst also reacting to breaking news and changing priorities.

Working to tight deadlines against the clock was paramount. Following this real and practical experience the students used professional autocue equipment to read, film and watch back their own news headlines.

Feedback from the sessions was very positive and it is hoped that they will become part of the annual EYR experience.
