Eastbourne Youth Radio (EYR) returns to the airwaves for the 21st year from 17th – 19th November 2021 on 87.7FM and online at www.eyr.org.uk. Broadcast from studios at East Sussex College in Eastbourne, EYR sees students aged from 5-19 from local schools and other organisations, present their radio shows covering a wide range of topics – much of it live. This year's broadcast coincides with several notable events. Namely, Anti-Bullying Week, Global Entrepreneurship Week, UK Parliament Week and finally BBC Children in Need. Individual programmes will cover all of these during the packed 3-day schedule.

EYR is only made possible by the considerable support and involvement of the many businesses and organisations that are detailed in the listing pages that follow.

EYR is all about enabling young people to research, produce, present and perform their own material in association with community partners for a family audience. From this they learn and develop a whole range of skills that they will find helpful in future life.

We hope that you enjoy listening to their work over the three days.

DON'T PLAY 'FLUSHING ROULETTE' WITH YOUR HOME

Our sewer network takes a lot of looking after to keep it running well – but we need help from our customers too. Flushing unflushable items like wet wipes, tampons, condoms and cotton buds starts a problem.

If you're lucky, they're caught at our wastewater treatment works – but that just means that, like last year, we took over 4,000 skips of unflushable items to landfill. Add in leftover cooking oil, fat, and grease poured down kitchen sinks and you've created a blockage in our sewers, which can lead to sewage flooding your home.

To avoid it, simply pop all unflushable items in the bin and cool leftover cooking fats, pour it into a container and throw it away.

Looking back:

21 YEARS ON THE AIR-WAVES

EYR launched in 2001 as a 24 hour pilot project to help engage students with local community projects and contribute to their citizenship work and personal development.

What made EYR unique was the range of student ages and other organisations that came together in a single project. Children from the age of 5 worked alongside post-16 students in the EYR studios. The project continues to contribute to curriculum and staff development and support various aspects of GCSE and BTEC courses.

Some 35,000 students have now taken part in EYR. Many of these have participated at primary, secondary and post-16 level before venturing into further and higher education, employment and in some cases the media industry itself. Former EYR'ers have worked at BBC Radio 2, Radio 4 and CBBC Radio together with independent radio stations, newspapers and general publishing.
