The *Partnership* is a group of organisations that work together to discuss the crime, safety and anti-social behavior issues that impact on our local communities. Meeting regularly helps member organisations, which include representatives from local police, fire & rescue services, probation services, along with borough and county councils, take a more rounded view of the changing patterns of crime, the challenges for local businesses, and those concerns that make local residents feel unsafe.

The partners commission work to help understand what the current priorities are, including those types of issues that are likely to be of interest to young people, such as staying safe online, tackling bullying, navigating unhealthy relationships, and being aware of the potential for exploitation and harm associated with drugs and gangs. The *Partnership* works with lots of local organisations to run awareness programmes and projects to help address these issues and can access some funding to help.
